1. **CALL TO ORDER**

- Lisa Van Laanen called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM.

2. **CHURCH STREET TOUR**

- The committee members toured future project areas on both Church Street and HWY 42.
- CHURCH ST:
 - The committee concurred that it doesn't want ANY bump-outs at all. Nada. In connection to that, we'd like to work with property owners regarding any driveway issues. In lieu of bump-outs, painted crosshatch markings next to driveways to indicate no parking would be an alternative, as in Sister Bay.
 - At the dog park, PPW concurred that we'd like a second driveway (or replacement driveway) that would border along the house to the north. Many advantages: a "Parking" sign would then be visible from the Market Street intersection, it could alleviate issues with existing dog park entryway, plus we'd have a significant now undeveloped scrub area between the two driveways to work with.
 - No parking along the Peg Egan, from north end of Ken's driveway to the north end of the Peg Egan. PPW agreed with Ken Mathys' suggestion of a Pocket Park-like creation incorporated the grassy area between Peg Egan's two driveways, adjacent to the sidewalk. This could be added to the project or done separately.
- HWY 42:
 - PPW concurred we'd like to work with property owners on their driveway, rather than add more bump-outs (the Guarino property doesn't seem as bad)
